WHO IS THE TAXPAYER?

2007 Tax Year:

- Direct Tax Yield 57% - Indirect Taxes 43%;
- Income Tax Accounted for 51% of Direct Taxes;
- PAYE Workers paid 75% of All Income Tax (80% in 2008);
- Public Service Workers paid 31% of all PAYE.

PAYE workers pay more tax than any other sector of Irish Society.

Public Service Workers contribute 31% of PAYE although they only account for 16% of the workforce.
